EPR Compliance

In 2016, the Government of India introduced the Plastic Waste Management rule which requires the producer companies and the brand owners to collect, treat and dispose packaging waste of the consumer products.

We engage with the producer companies to meet this in accordance with the norms set in the Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) policy.

We recover, segregate and transport the plastic wastes to the recycling or co-processing units. Additionally, we conduct awareness programs to the consumers & various stakeholders of plastic. We believe in ethical procurement of plastic waste adopting to the Standard and Ethical Operational Guidelines.

Zero Waste Events

Green Worms renders pragmatic, sustainable and complete waste management solutions to all kinds of events. The Waste Management Rules, 2016 made the event organizers responsible for ensuring proper segregation of waste in any event attended by more than 100 people. Our concept of Zero Waste Events are designed to address this issue.

All the wastes generated during a zero-waste event are reused, recycled and composted. The goal is to prevent anything ending up in landfills.

We have successfully managed large scale events including the annual Cochin Carnival which has 3 Lakhs Visitors.

Oceans Plastic Recovery

Green Worms work with Brand Owners, Government bodies & other key stakeholders to recover Plastics from the seas, rivers & coastal regions. We engage local women, fishermen & grassroots communities to help and recover plastic waste. The collected plastic wastes are stored in our Material Collection Facility (MCF) centrers. At MCF, the recovered plastic is cleaned and segregated. The segregated recyclable Plastics shall be carried to the recycling units through Green worms' partners. The non-recyclable Plastics are transported for co-processing.

We are working with the ULBs in Lakshadweep to recover Ocean bound Plastics


